As of now, IIT Palakkad has only one Center of Excellence, which is the</p>

However, we are committed to expanding our research and innovation ecosystem and establishing more Centers of Excellence in various fields in the future.</p> <p>b) The Global Sanitation Center of Excellence (GSCOE) at IIT Palakkad has been fully funded by Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds received by the institute. Therefore, no funds have been allocated by the Ministry of Education for the development and support of this center. The total CSR funds received for</p>
